



# The Process

---

Thank you for choosing Encore Fence as your fence company. We want to make this process as seamless as possible for you. Here is a schedule of what each day of the installation looks like.

## Day 1

### **DEMO DAY**

#### Existing Fence Take Down

Upon arrival we will remove your existing fence.

### **SET POST**

#### Dig Holes and Set Post

Once the existing fence is removed and out of the way. We begin to dig holes. Holes take different amounts of time depending on soil and rocks. If the ground has a lot of rocks in it, this process can take double or even triple the time. After all holes are dug. The install team will set your post in the ground, make sure the post is even, and fill the holes with cement.

## Day 2-3

### **DRY DAY**

#### Post Need time to dry

The second or third day is meant for the post to dry. We want to make sure the post are as dry as possible before we start hanging fence on them. The worst thing you can do is rush this process and put weight on post that are not ready.

## DAY 3-5

### **FINAL DAY**

#### Hanging Pickets/ Chain Link/ Panels and gates to complete your project!

YAY! The final day of your fence installation! This is the best day of this process. You finally get to see the fence you've been imagining. Today we will complete the process by putting up the pickets and your gates. At the end of this day the fence will be complete.

Each process can extend another day depending on the size of the project as well as the weather.
